- 3 railway packages (2001 2004 2007)
- Liberalisation of passenger traffic
 - International traffic: January 2010
 - National traffic: proposal European Commission expected in 2012
- Recast first railway package 2010
 - Updating and optimization of legislation
 - Also implications for stations and passengers
